There's plenty to see whatever time of year you visit the Islands - plenty of birds including many seabirds, flora and fauna, wildlife such as grey seals and the most fantastic scenery.

A warm welcome awaits you at Colossus B&B where we take pleasure in offering quality accommodation, excellent food and value for money. Colossus is a friendly Scillonian family run B&B offering accommodation in super king-sized double or twin bedded rooms with ensuite facilities, television, hot drink making facilities, radio alarm clock and hairdryer. DVD and broadband wi-fi access are available also.

Our home and garden overlook the lower moors and are situated in a residential cul-de-sac. Only a 7 minute walk with splendid views brings you to Hugh Town, where you will find shops, restaurants, public houses and three beaches - Porthcressa, Porthmellon and Town Beach. A further 2 minutes brings you to the harbour - where you can hop on the daily boats to take you to the off-islands.

Close by is a delightful coastal walk around the spectacular Penninis headland. Five minutes walk in the opposite direction will bring you to the picturesque village of Old Town, with cafes and art and craft studios.

Bedrooms

Colossus offers guests well appointed en-suite rooms which can be either a super-king sized double or have two 3ft twin beds. Each room has a digital television, hot drink making facilities, heating, an easy chair, radio alarm clock and hairdryer.

One room is situated on the ground floor and overlooks the front garden showing off its succulents and a silver tree (Leucadendron) and the other is situated on the first floor with two big velux windows looking towards the sky and on clear nights you can view a vast constellation of beautiful stars.

Both bedrooms are light and airy and furnished to a high standard as proven by our 4 star English Tourist/Visit Britain rating.

Shower Rooms

Each room is tastefully decorated and has a shower room with WC and basin and heated towel rails. The room on the ground floor has a power shower.



Dining Room

Breakfast is served each morning in our bright and cheerful dining room decked with shipwreck flooring and artifacts. A good choice of cooked and cold breakfast are offered together with a breakfast bar of cereals, yogurts, juices and fruit. Produce is sought locally and used when available.

Over breakfast there is often an opportunity for you to ask questions about the islands and for us to impart our knowledge of local tales, history and stories of Scilly's shipwrecks.

Communal Room
